Description: Hamilton Paramedic Services as outlined as an event, response and transports. An event is generated every time a person calls 911 and requests the assistance of a paramedic through our Central Ambulance Communication Centre. A response is the number of paramedic vehicles that are sent to an event. Transports are the total number of patients who are transported to hospital by a paramedic. Provided in Tabular Format.
